Grassland Lodge - Central Kalahari

Our journey continues by road from Maun, deep into Botswana's wild heart. After winding through cattle farmland and sandy tracks, we arrive at Grassland Safari Lodge—a family-owned, generational retreat born from a former cattle farm and now transformed into a private game reserve spanning more than 10,000 hectares adjacent to the vast Central Kalahari Game Reserve.

Here, wildlife freely crosses between protected lands and the reserve, bringing the wilderness right to your doorstep.

This is not just a stop on the map—it's a place where heritage, hospitality, and wilderness converge to create something truly rare. From the moment you arrive, you're welcomed not as a guest, but as part of the family.




Cultural Immersion

Discover the ancient traditions, storytelling, and bushcraft of the San, one of the world's oldest Indigenous cultures.




































Horseback Safaris

For confident riders, horseback safaris offer a thrilling and unique way to approach wildlife on the open Kalahari.












Rhino Tracking with the Naro Bushmen

Walk alongside skilled San trackers as they follow white rhino trails—an unforgettable blend of culture and conservation.










Living Conservation: Protecting Predators

Grassland leads predator conflict mitigation by relocating lions and carnivores that stray onto farmland into a natural five-hectare enclosure. Here, lions and endangered African wild dogs can be observed before release back into the wild. Wildlife numbers shift with ongoing relocations, making each visit unique.

























Game Drives
















A Place That Feels Like Home
